For competitors who are resident in England, entry is ONLY open to members or who have made application to be members of the English Karate Federation.

For competitors outside of England, entry is ONLY open to members of the respective National Governing Body which is in membership of the World Karate Federation (WKF).

# Information for all Coaches and Competitors

1. Coach Packs will be available from 9.00 am in the main hall.  
Coach passes will be allocated on the following basis.  
Up to 9 competitors entered = 1 Pass  
over 10 competitors = 2 Passes  
over 20 competitors = 3 Passes
2. Only coaches wearing passes will have access to all areas and must be suitably attired i.e. club tracksuit etc.
3. The Chief Referee will hold a coaches meeting at 9.15 am to advise competition rules.
4. WKF rules will be applied on the day. There may be additional amendments at the discretion of the Chief Referee which will be announced at the Coaches meeting.
5. All contestants must wear a clean white Gi and have a fitted gum shields if entering a Kumite category. Coloured belts and mitts are required but will not be provided by the organiser.
6. Any known style Kata maybe performed and the Bunkai in the team final is optional. The Chief Referee will advise further details on Kata at the coaches meeting. **Senior Grade Kata will be strictly WKF rules.**
7. All Coaches are required to ensure that their competitors are licensed and fully comply with the categories entered. Any person in the wrong category either through age, weight or grade will be disqualified with **no refund.**
8. The organiser reserves the right to change or cancel any category not sufficiently filled.
8. All clubs/associations are asked to offer available qualified referees and/or timekeepers.
9. Please advise the organiser before the closing date.  
Free admittance and refreshments will be made available to all officials.
10. Each event will be fought to the finish, no waiting for the finals at the end of the night.

**Junior matches** will last **one and half minutes**

**Senior matches** will last **two minutes**

11. In accordance with Karate Child Protection policy, photography in and around the area's is totally prohibited without a Photographer's pass. Passes can be obtained on the day from Terry Pottage. Anyone seen taking pictures without a pass will be removed from the Competition.
